

Spaces available for naming rights



There has been a great deal of care, consideration and consultation focused on creating a homelike, comforting and supportive environment. The design features and colour schemes are warm and welcoming and carpet will be used in all areas where clinically appropriate.

Patient Rooms:

Each room is a modern, comfortable, supportive retreat, where care can be administered and the privacy of patients is assured. The rooms are large enough to provide ample space for families to visit and support their loved one. Each patient's room opens on to a private courtyard, which is a key feature of the development.

Dining and Family Room:

The dining and family room provides a homely environment where patients can come together and share a meal. As much as possible the rooms at Caritas have been designed to have an intimate, appealing, non-institutional feel. Further, smaller family rooms are included throughout.

Function, Education and Group Room:

The multi-function room provides a setting for social and communal activities and for group activities. It is also the ideal space for palliative care education, training and discussions to take place.

Central Courtyard:

In addition to the private garden spaces accessed from patient rooms, there will be extensive garden and landscaped spaces for shared enjoyment. The central Caritas courtyard will be available for naming.

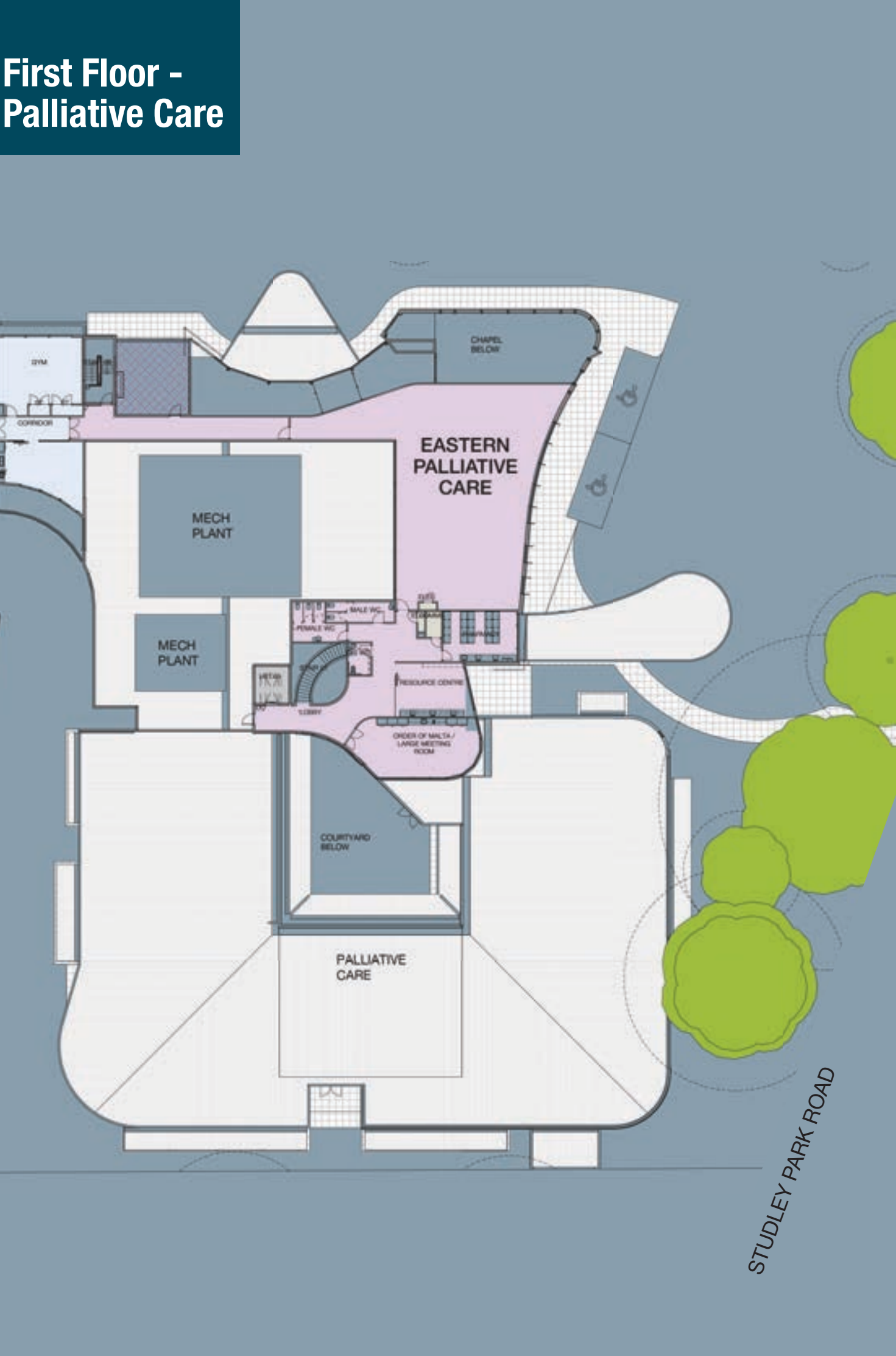
