# **Guidelines for Toy Donations**

To minimise the risk of cross infection, we have provided some instructions on the types of toys suitable for ongoing handling, cleaning storage and use in a hospital environment.

# **Toy Selection:**

The instructions below provide a guide to the types of toys St Vincent's Private Hospital are able to accept. Cleaning and repeated use should be taken into account when selecting your gift.

# Please donate:

- New toys only
- Toys for children over 3 years of age.
- o Ideally, toys made of plastic and of solid construction.

## We regret we're unable to accept:

- Used or preowned toys. Unfortunately, due to the risk of infection, we're unable to accept toys that have already been played with.
- Toys with small parts which could be a choke hazard.
- o Fabric and soft fluffy toys are unfortunately not suitable for hospital use.
- Wooden toys should be avoided as wood is porous and renders bacteria to become inaccessible to cleaning.
- o Bath toys and toys that retain water.
- o Books, as there are difficult to disinfect.
